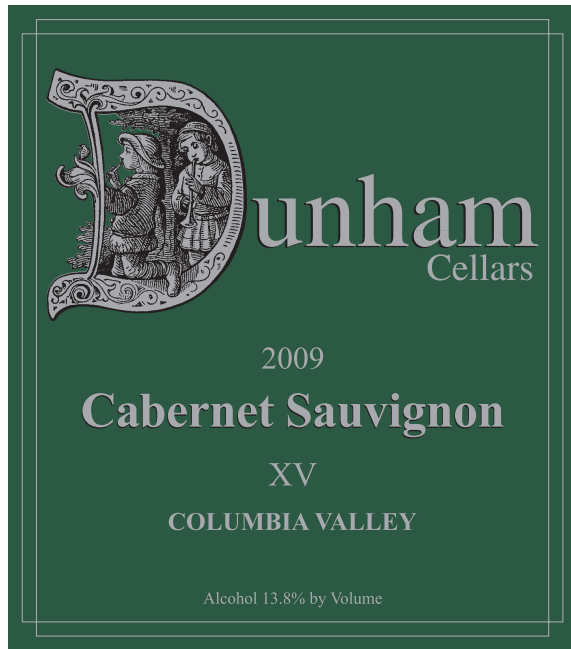


DUNHAM CELLARS | 2009 CABERNET SAUVIGNON XV
